DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER ACROSS THE STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA, THE DUE DATE FOR ALL CDBG-CV APPLICATIONS HAS BEEN EXTENDED. ALL APPLICATIONS FOR CDBG-CV FUNDS ARE NOW DUE TO THE WVCAD OFFICE ON OR BEFORE 5:00P.M. ON WEDNESDAY MARCH 31, 2021.

Each project must meet the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) National Objective to benefit at least 51% or more low- and moderate-income persons. The State of West Virginia Amended FY2019 Consolidated Annual Action Plan which outlines the CDBG-CV program is posted on www.wvcad.org/resources under the HUD Consolidated Plan and Summary header.
