Grant Funding Opportunity - The WV Department of Economic Development is pleased to announce the State is accepting project proposals for the **Housing Opportunities for Persons with HIV/AIDS (HOPWA).** This is a three-year grant program cycle (2023-2026). Awards will be made for the first 12-month performance period within the annual funding cycle beginning October 1, 2023, and ending September 30th, 2024. (Subsequent awards within the grant program cycle will be made annually.) HOPWA funding is provided to the State by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Eligible applicants include 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations that either have experience in serving persons living with HIV/AIDS (PLWHA) or plan to through utilization of new and existing partners, referrals, and resources experienced in serving this special population.
