The State of West Virginia Community Development Block Grant - Coronavirus (CDBG-CV1) application is now available on the West Virginia Community Advancement and Development (WVCAD) website, under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) header, at the following address: www.wvcad.org/resources. Please note, only Non-Entitlement Cities and Counties are eligible to apply but may serve as a pass-through entity for Non-Profit Organizations.

ALL APPLICATIONS FOR CDBG-CV1 FUNDS ARE DUE TO THE WVCAD OFFICE ON OR BEFORE 5:00P.M. ON FRIDAY OCTOBER 30, 2020.

Each project must meet the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) National Objective to benefit at least 51% or more low- and moderate-income persons.

The State of West Virginia Amended FY2019 Consolidated Annual Action Plan which outlines the CDBG-CV1 program is posted on www.wvcad.org/resources under the HUD Consolidated Plan and Summary header.

WVCAD CDBG Program staff will conduct two webinars to review the CDBG-CV1 application and to provide an opportunity for potential applicants to ask questions. The first session is scheduled for Wednesday, September 23rd at 2:00PM and the second session is scheduled for Thursday, September 24th at 1:00PM.
