

Questions from Innovative MIT Project Presentation – March 17, 2021

Q1: Are any 100% MIT funding projects considered?

Yes, 100% MIT projects are considered. Leveraged funds will increase application score.

Q2: Would separation of combined sewers projects be eligible?

I believe this would be eligible, if the sewer projects were located in the 12 MIT counties. We can talk in our one-on-one meetings.

Q3: Is the West Virginia Division of Highways an eligible Applicant for a large storm sewer project that qualifies by LMA?

Yes, all state agencies are eligible for the CDBG-MIT trainings.

Q4: Sherry, Can a PSD apply for HUD-MIT funding to match a US Army Corps of Engineers Section 14 Bank Stabilization that the Corps will be administering the project, selecting and hiring the contractor and requesting the required 35% match in advance. This project stabilizes current main sanitary sewer lines to the treatment facility.

The FRN limits the amount of DR or MIT funding for such projects up to \$250,000 but we need more details about the project to fully confirm.
